After consideration of the facts in the above referenced case, the Underground Technical Committee has made the following decision:

3781.28(A) - Non-Compliant - No OUPS Ticket

As a result, you are being issued the following fine and penalty:

The Underground Technical Committee (UTC) finds the Respondent violated obligation under ORC 3781.28(A). Respondent shall remit a \$250.00 monetary penalty and complete mandatory training and submit documentation of training and attendance no later than June 30, 2020 or 90 days from the lift of the current emergency declaration. This training shall include excavation near underground facilities, excavation near Interstate and Intrastate pipelines, one call process, mandatory monitoring requirements for pipelines and the dangers associated with damages to underground facilities to include potential impact radius, how to identify release and impact of not reporting damages to facility owners. The UTC reserves the right to seek additional penalties should this corrective action is not completed within the specified timeframe.

Due to the gravity of the violation and the potential for significant impact to life and environment, the Respondent is mandated to pay a monetary penalty of \$250.00 within 30 days of notification.

Payment of your fine is due no later than <u>05/11/2020</u>. Failure to pay your fine may result in additional collection fees and penalties. **Please include case number 20-00004 with your payment.**
