Lifeline Eligibility Requirements

Based on Your Income

A customer can get Lifeline if their income is 135% or less than the Federal Poverty Guidelines (see the table below). The guideline is based on your household size and state.

The table below reflects 135% of the 2024 Federal Poverty Guidelines.

They may have to show proof of income, like a tax return or three consecutive pays stubs, when they apply for Lifeline.

Based on If They Use SNAP, Medicaid, or Other Programs

- Federal Assistance Programs
- They can get Lifeline if you (or someone in their household) participate in one of these programs:
- Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP), formerly known as Food Stamps
- Medicaid
 - Their Medicaid eligibility may be up for renewal. Learn more about how to renew (Spanish language information).
- Supplemental Security Income (SSI)
- Federal Public Housing Assistance (FPHA)
- Veterans Pension and Survivors Benefit

They may have to show proof of participation, like a benefit letter or official document, when they apply for Lifeline.

Tribal Assistance Programs

If they live on Tribal lands, they can get Lifeline if your household income is at or below 135% of the Federal Poverty Guidelines, or if you (or someone in your household) participate in:

- Any of the federal assistance programs listed above
- Bureau of Indian Affairs General Assistance
- Head Start (only households meeting the income qualifying standard)
- Tribal Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (Tribal TANF)

Food Distribution Program on Indian Reservations

They may have to show proof of participation, like a benefit letter or official document, when they apply for Lifeline. Learn more about the Tribal Benefit.

Qualify Through Your Child or Dependent

They can get Lifeline if their child or dependent participates in any of the programs listed above.
