Dear Ms. Troupe:

The following supplemental information is provided to update the application filed in the above-referenced proceeding on June 8, 2021.

On page 1, the first paragraph under "Brief Description of the Project" should be revised to read as follows:

Duke Energy Ohio proposes to remove and replace six existing monopole structures and one H-frame structure (comprising two single poles), and to install three new, permanent structures. Specifically, the Project will include two self-supporting engineered steel poles, seven direct embed steel monopoles, and one h-frame structure, along with approximately 950 feet of new conductor per phase. The Project is located entirely within an existing Duke Energy Ohio right of way (ROW) and easement.

On page 4, the following table should be inserted at the end of "4906-6-05(B)(9)(a): Operating Characteristics":
