Overview of requested changes

Detariffing and related actions pursuant to Case No. 10-1010-TP-ORD.

With this filing, Choice One Communications of Ohio Inc. proposes to replace in its entirety the Company's P.U.C.O. Tariff No. 3 (local and interexchange services tariff) with P.U.C.O. Tariff No. 4 (local/BLES services tariff).

Details of requested changes

In the proposed new tariff, P.U.C.O. Tariff No. 4 the following changes were made:

- Consolidated service descriptions, current rates and maximum ranges to a single section (Section 6) – no changes were made to these products or rates.
- Removed products that are no longer to be included in the tariff per PUCO rules:
 - features – except for free blocking services
 - directory listings – other than the main listings
 - directory assistance
 - operator services
 - interexchange services section of the tariff – the PIC Change Charge remains in the tariff in Section 6.5
- Replaced customer deposits language with statement that Company will administer in accordance with Retail Telecommunication Services rules as codified in §4901:1-6 and §4901:1-17-05 in the Ohio Administrative Code.
- Removed Returned Check Charge language.
- In the “Additional Provisions Applicable to Business Customers” section from Section 2 – removed deposits and dishonored checks language.
- In the “Additional Provisions Applicable to Residential Customers” section from Section 2 – removed deposits language, installment billing language, adjusted payment schedule language, dishonored checks language, backbilling language and disconnection language.
- Removed the “Automatic Number Identification” language from Section 2.
- Added statement to title page of tariff stating that tariff describes the terms and conditions, services and rates applicable to the provisioning of Basic Local Exchange Services regulated and tariffed in accordance with Chapter 4901:1-6, Ohio Administrative Code (O.A.C.) and that Company agrees to abide by the regulations contained in Retail Telecommunication Services rules as set forth in the Ohio Administrative Code.
- Removed many blank pages/sections from tariff (from last detariffing effort in 2008) which helped us to reduce the size of the tariff from 374 pages to 68 pages.
