AMENDED INFORMATION TO SUPPLEMENT DUKE ENERGY OHIO, INC.'S APPLICATION FOR APPROVAL OF A LONG TERM FORECAST AND RESOURCE PLAN

On March 25, 2011, Duke Energy Ohio, Inc. (Duke Energy Ohio) submitted a motion for a waiver of the Commission's rule requiring that long term forecasts and resource plans be submitted on April 15 of each year. The Commission granted Duke Energy Ohio's motion and permitted the Company to submit its application in this proceeding on June 15, 2011, and on June 15, 2011, the Company submitted its Long Term Forecast and Resource Plan, (Plan). Thereafter, various parties intervened in the proceeding. Ohio Revised Code Section 4935.04 states that the Commission must hold a hearing ninety days after the Company's Plan is filed upon the showing of good cause by an interested party. During the pendency of the Company's Plan, it has been determined that several schedules required by the Commission's rules were inadvertently omitted from the initial filing. Additionally, the Company's original forecast was based upon planning for the load the Company served under its standard service offer, (SSO) load. The Commission Staff subsequently requested that the Company provide a forecast for all load in its service territory. Accordingly, the Company is amending certain information and

including information that was originally omitted. The information that is attached includes the following documents:

1) Twenty-two pages of updated LTFR forms to provide forecast information related to all Standard Service Offer load, including:

Form FE-R10 that was not included in the original filing.

For FE-R10 corrected for capital costs used in the analysis.

It is anticipated that this amended information will fulfill of all of the Commission's requirements. The Company respectfully requests that the Commission accept these additional documents as the final required filing.
