

Bypassable Generation and Transmission Related Component - Charges for purchasing power and delivering it through the transmission system. These charges are avoided when switching to a Certified Retail

Cost Recovery Charges - Recovers previously incurred costs, including PUCO-approved Phase-In Recovery Charges OE collects from all customers on behalf of OE Funding, LLC which owns the right to impose and collect sind before

such charges - Monthly charge that offsets costs for billing, meter reading, equipment, and service line maintenance.

Distribution Related Component - Charge for moving electricity over

distribution lines to a service location.

Economic Development Component - Charges related to economic

development support. **Estimated Reading -** On the months we do not read a meter, we calcu**l**ate

the bill based on past electrical usage.

KWH (Kilowatt Hour) - A unit of measure for electricity usage equal to 1,000 watts used for one hour.


