

- (3) On November 6, 2006, the examiner established a procedural schedule in these proceedings. Since that time, the examiner has been informed that the parties may be pursuing settlement discussions and that the established schedule is not workable for at least some parties. Therefore, the examiner finds that the procedural schedule should be modified.
- (4) Testimony to be filed by any intervenor or by staff will be due no later than November 29, 2006.
- (5) The hearing previously scheduled for November 30, 2006, will be continued until a date to be established by subsequent entry.
- (6) On November 9, 2006, staff of the Commission filed a motion to modify the time period to be considered in staff's audit of the SRT. Staff suggests that, rather than ending on June 30, 2006, the audit period should end on May 31, 2006. This change will allow the peak demand months of June, July, and August to be reviewed and considered together in this and subsequent audits. Staff believes that this change will result in a better review of the SRT. Staff also requests an expedited ruling on this motion and certifies that it has discussed its motion with all other parties and that no party objects to the substance of the motion or to its expedited treatment.
- (7) The examiner agrees that modifying the audit period to end on May 31, 2006, will improve the outcome of the Commission's review, as it will allow the peak months to be considered together. Therefore, the motion will be granted.

It is, therefore,


ORDERED, That testimony be filed as set forth in finding (4). It is, further,

ORDERED, That the previously scheduled hearing be continued until a date to be established by subsequent entry. It is, further,

ORDERED, That the motion to modify the audit period for the SRT be modified as set forth in finding (7). It is, further,

ORDERED, That a copy of this entry be served upon Energy Ventures Analysis, Inc., and all parties of record in this proceeding.


