FINDING AND ORDER

The Commission finds:

- (1) Hi-Grade Oil Co. (Respondent) was timely served with a notice of preliminary determination in accordance with Rule 4901:-2-7-12, Ohio Administrative Code (O.A.C.). In the notice of preliminary determination, the Commission Staff proposed a forfeiture of \$675.00 for alleged violations of the shipping paper requirements of the Hazardous Materials Regulations, 49 C.F.R. Section 177.817, as adopted by this Commission.
- (2) On June 14, 2005, Respondent filed a request for an administrative hearing regarding the notice of preliminary determination issued by the Staff.
- (3) On August 14, 2006, the Staff and the Respondent filed a settlement agreement in this case. Among the terms of the settlement agreement, the Respondent agrees to make payment of a civil forfeiture of \$337.50. The settlement agreement resolves all factual and legal issues in this case.
- (4) Rules 4901-1-30 and 4901:2-7-11, O.A.C., authorize parties to these proceedings to enter into stipulations and settlement agreements. Although not binding upon the Commission, stipulations are entitled to careful scrutiny and consideration, particularly where all parties have joined together in the stipulation. See, Cincinnati Gas and Electric Company, Case No. 76-302-EL-AIR (Opinion and Order dated May 4, 1977). The settlement agreement entered into between the Staff and Respondent represents a fair and equitable settlement of this matter and should be approved and adopted by the Commission.
