## AMERICAN MUNICIPAL POWER-OHIO, INC.'S NOTICE REGARDING FULLY DEVELOPED INFORMATION FOR ANY ALTERNATE SITE FOR ITS PROPOSED ELECTRIC POWER GENERATING STATION AND RELATED FACILITIES

American Municipal Power-Ohio, Inc. ("AMP-Ohio") is in the process of preparing for consideration by the Ohio Power Siting Board ("Board") an Application for a Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need ("Certificate") to construct an electric power generating station and related facilities ("generating station") to supply the needs of its members and project partners. With this filing, please take notice that pursuant Ohio Administrative Code ("OAC") 4906-5-04(A), AMP-Ohio's to-be-filed Certificate Application in the above-captioned matter will *not* include fully developed information for any alternate site for the proposed generating station. OAC 4906-5-04 expressly states that "[a]pplicants for electric power generating facilities . . . may choose to include fully developed information on two or more sites." Therefore, an applicant is required only to provide fully developed information for a single site of the applicant's choosing. Of course, AMP-Ohio's Application will be responsive to the applicable rules for its selected site for the proposed generating station.
