I am requesting you deny approving the application for the Rockies Express East Pipeline project running through my property for the following reasons:

Such a monstrous, extremely high pressure pipeline transporting up to 2 billion cubic feet a day of natural gas across the U.S., does not belong in Johnson County or any other county that is part of the Greater People's Water Area for safety, health, environmental, and economic reasons. A pipeline will adversely affect the safety, health and welfare of the citizens of Johnson County; the environment of Johnson County. (We have endangered species on my property.... bald eagles and gray bats)

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and future economic development. Not only is our safety jeopardized by the proposed pipeline, but the natural, physical landscape of Johnson County would be forever destroyed. Numerous plants and wildlife (and many are) are native to the area where the pipeline is to be constructed. The construction route will bulldoze over and through our wooded areas, ravines, gullies, creeks and fields forever obliterating our natural beauty. Also this route will destroy certified woodlands including over 100 year old trees!
