Dear Senator Jackman:

I am writing to advise you of my October 5, 2006 letter expressing concerns about the proposed Rockies Express - East pipeline to the chairman of the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission, Joseph Kelliher.

As you know, Rockies Express Pipeline LLC's proposed 622-mile interstate natural gas pipeline would extend from Audrain County, Missouri, to Monroe County, Ohio. Interstate natural gas pipelines must undergo a federal process and be approved by the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission or FERC. Rockies Express - East would run through nine Indiana counties, including Johnson, Shelby, Decatur and Franklin Counties, part of the Sixth Congressional District which I represent.

My letter to FERC expresses my concerns and those of my constituents regarding this project. Please find it enclosed.
