ENTRY

The Commission finds:

- (1) On October 31, 2006, Cheryl Harvey filed a complaint against American Electric Power/Columbus Southern Power Company (AEP) concerning collection activities on a prior account.
- (2) Subsequently, AEP filed an answer to the complaint. In the answer, the company stated that it has satisfied the complaint. Citing Rule 4901-9-01(E), Ohio Administrative Code (O.A.C.), AEP indicated that the complaint should be dismissed as a settled case.
- (3) Rule 4901-9-01(E), O.A.C., provides that, if the public utility complained against files an answer or motion which asserts that the complaint has been satisfied and no response is filed within 20 days, the Commission may presume that satisfaction has occurred and dismiss the complaint.
