Liberty Power is in the process of setting up two entities to do business in the state of Delaware, Liberty Power Holdings and Liberty Power Delaware. Our application to do business has already been submitted. Please accept this letter which explains the need for these two entities.

Liberty Power is working with a couple of different financing sources. Each one requires a "bankruptcy remote" entity. What this means is that in the event that anything were to happen to Liberty Power Corp (the parent company), the financing source wants to be able to recover its financing which is secured by the contracts under the licensed entities. To do this, they would need to be able to strip out the duly licensed subsidiary operating company and continue to operate until the contract terms were completed.





**EXHIBIT B-2 "Experience & Plans":** Liberty Power has been selling electricity by telemarketing and door-to-door. Our Sales Channels call prospective small to medium size business customers, if they accept, the enrollment process begins.

Liberty Power does not enroll customers until they have met the following qualifications:

- 1) They have provided a written authorization or Third Party Verified verbal authorization.
- 2) A welcome letter has been sent from Liberty Power Delaware and the customer has not cancelled within 6 days of the requested switch.

Liberty Power Delaware will be served by Liberty Power Corp's customer care team. Inhouse training and documentation is used for training new customer care representatives when needed. Furthermore, Liberty Power Corp's infrastructure, including call center infrastructure which documents call tracking metrics and allows for management assessment of resource requirements to ensure compliance with expected customer service levels.

Liberty Power will focus mainly on doing business with large C&I customers that we already have existing accounts with so that we can serve their branches in other areas.
