The Commission finds:

- (1) This docket was opened in order to, among other things, establish the format, structure and methodology to be used in arriving at local exchange company access charge and toll compensation levels for the Ohio intrastate jurisdiction. Since 1990, there has not been any significant, industry-wide access-charge-related Commission policy adopted in this docket. However, there have been numerous company-specific tariff filings and an occasional ruling on a company-specific waiver request.
- (2) Due to the sheer size and number of documents contained in this case file, coupled with the age of the docket, the Commission finds it appropriate at this time to close Case No. 83-464-TP-COI (83-464) of record and open a new docket into which access charge-related filings currently made in 83-464 can be made. Accordingly, the Docketing Division is instructed to close 83-464 of record on the last business day of 2006 and open a new docket on the first business day of 2007. That new docket opened in 2007 shall be Case No. 07-464-TP-UNC. The action being taken to close 83-464 in no way diminishes the obligations of regulated telephone companies to continue to comply with the requirements of the orders rendered in 83-464. Any new application for waiver of the requirements of an 83-464 order shall be filed as a new case and reference the requirements of the applicable 83-464 order.

ORDERED, That Case No. 83-464-TP-COI be closed of record and a new case opened as discussed in finding 2. It is, further,
