ENTRY

The Attorney Examiner finds:

- (1) On December 15, 2006, Vectren Energy Delivery of Ohio, Inc. (Vectren) and Commission Staff filed a Stipulation and Recommendation (Stipulation) resolving all of the issues raised in these cases except one. The management performance (m/p) auditor recommended that Vectren refund to gas cost recovery customers \$831,740 for Vectren's 5 percent reserve margin for the period November 1, 2002 through October 1, 2003 (04-220-GA-GCR m/p audit report filed August 16, 2006 at pgs. 30, 74). Vectren and Staff were not able to reach a resolution of this issue and, therefore, submit the issue to the Commission for its consideration.
- (2) There are two other parties to these proceedings, the Office of Ohio Consumers' Counsel (OCC) and Interstate Gas Supply, Inc. OCC contacted the Attorney Examiner assigned to this proceeding and requested time to brief the unresolved issue. Briefs regarding the m/p auditor's recommendation for a refund of Vectren's reserve margin expense shall be due by January 3, 2007. Any reply briefs shall be due by January 12, 2007.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That briefs regarding Vectren's reserve margin shall be due by January 3, 2007. Any reply briefs shall be due by January 12, 2007. It is further,

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ORDERED, That a copy of this Entry be served upon all parties of record.
