ENTRY

The Commission finds:

- (1) By entry of January 4, 2006, the Commission, in part, ordered Norfolk Southern Railway (NS) to construct an active grade crossing warning device at Stanley Road, Vermilion Township, Erie County (472-316M). The project was ordered to be in service no later than January 4, 2007.
- (2) On December 21, 2006, NS filed a request for a 60-day extension of time in which to complete the project. NS indicated that completion of the project was delayed due to adverse weather including high winds and rain which prevented First Energy Corp. from relocating overhead utility lines which would have enabled NS to complete the project. NS stated that due to the unpredictability of weather at this time of year, it is requesting a 60-day extension within which to complete the project.
- (3) On December 22, 2006, staff filed a memorandum recommending that the Commission approve NS's request.
- (4) Upon review, good cause exists to grant a 60-day extension of time in order to complete this project. Accordingly, NS should complete the project by March 4, 2007. In addition, during this time period, NS should provide progress reports to staff on the status of the project.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That NS's request for an extension of time to complete the project be granted. It is, further,
