The Universal Service Fund Rider shall be assessed on all kilowatt-hours (kWh) of electricity distributed under this Schedule at the rates stated below, effective on a bills-rendered basis in the Company's first cycle billing unit for the month of January 2007.

\$0.0009297 per kWh for the first 833,000 kWh  
\$0.0005700 per kWh for all kWh over 833,000 kWh

The Universal Service Fund is a statewide program which was established under Section 4928.52 of the Ohio Revised Code to be implemented by the Director of Development. The purpose of the fund is to provide qualified Low-Income Customers in Ohio with income-based bills and energy efficiency education programs.

The Universal Service charge for electric service as required by Distribution Tariff Sheets contained in this Schedule shall be the product of the billing kWh and the Universal Service Fund Rider.
