ENTRY

The Attorney Examiner finds:

- (1) On December 31, 1998, C. Abatsas (Complainant) filed a complaint with the Commission against East Ohio Gas Company (East Ohio). Complainant alleges that East Ohio has unlawfully terminated gas service to 3245 West 25<sup>th</sup> Street, Cleveland, Ohio.
- (2) A settlement conference was scheduled for this case on February 4, 1999, in an effort to settle this matter informally.
- (3) Complainant did not appear at the settlement conference. At the time of the prehearing, the gas service to Complainant's address had been restored. The Attorney Examiner conducting the settlement conference tried unsuccessfully to contact Complainant by telephone with regard to this matter. Given the amount of time that has elapsed, and the fact that Complainant has not contacted the Commission regarding this complaint, it is not clear that Complainant wishes to pursue this matter.
- (4) If Complainant still wants the Commission to have a hearing in this matter, he should notify the Commission in writing at the following address by July 28, 2000:

- (5) If Complainant, C. Abatsas, does not want a hearing in this matter, or if he does not respond to this Entry as requested, above, then the Attorney Examiner will recommend to the Commission that this case be dismissed.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That if Complainant, C. Abatsas, wishes a hearing in this matter, he notify the Commission in writing by July 28, 2000 at the address set forth in Finding 4, above. It is, further,

ORDERED, That a copy of this Entry be served upon each party of record.


