ENTRY

The attorney examiner finds:

- (1) On November 20, 2006, Tiffany Ridge Townhouse Condominium Unit Owners' Association, Inc. (complainant) filed a complaint alleging that Cleveland Electric Illuminating Company (CEI) improperly redirected one of the power lines that served a pump station to the complainant. Complainant also alleged that, as a result, the pump station flooded and had to be pumped out at additional cost to complainant.
- (2) On January 3, 2007, following a request for an extension of time, CEI filed an answer which denied the material allegations of the complaint.
- (3) The attorney examiner finds that a settlement conference should be held in this matter on February 6, 2007, at 10:00 a.m., in Hearing Room 11-F, at the offices of the Commission, 180 East Broad Street, Columbus, Ohio 43215.
- (4) In the event that a settlement is not reached at the conference, the attorney examiner will conduct a discussion of procedural issues at the conclusion of the settlement conference. Procedural issues for discussion may include discovery dates, possible stipulations of facts, and potential hearing dates.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That a settlement conference be held in accordance with Finding (3). It is, further,

ORDERED, That a copy of this entry be served upon all parties of record.
