
The Commission finds:

- (1) On December 13, 2006, David Brumert (complainant) filed a complaint with the Commission against The East Ohio Gas Company d/b/a Dominion East Ohio (Dominion). Mr. Brumert claims that his meter was not read for several years and that, once the meter was read, Dominion billed him more than \$1,900.00. Mr. Brumert requests that Dominion recognize that he has installed energy efficient windows and replaced his old furnace with a high-efficiency furnace with a programmable thermostat. The complainant contends that Dominion has overcharged him.
- (2) On December 29, 2006, Mr. Brumert and Dominion filed a joint motion to dismiss the complaint. The parties state that all matters raised in this complaint have been resolved and, therefore, they request that the complaint be dismissed with prejudice.
- (3) The parties' request to dismiss this complaint with prejudice is reasonable and should be granted.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That this complaint is closed of record and dismissed with prejudice. It is, further,




