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NOTICE

Pursuant to the Stipulation and Agreement signed by the Commission on September 9, 1999, The Cincinnati Gas & Electric Company ("CG&E") gives notice as follows.

The Stipulation and Agreement required CG&E to complete a review of its dispatch and leak investigation procedures to determine how these procedures may be improved through the use of ED SIP and RA CAD, then file quarterly status reports.

CG&E previously entered into a contract with its software consultant, Convergent Group Corporation (Convergent), to study the feasibility of a technology tool for Gas Odor Reporting and Gas Pipeline Safety applications within ED SIP.

Convergent is currently developing the interface between Smallworld's Cathodic Protection (CP) Tool and CG&E's Corrosion Control Monitoring System (CCMS) to allow for proper transfer of data. At the same time, Convergent is addressing CG&E's request to modify Smallworld to allow for the physical placement of pipe-to-soil readings on the electronic maps in relation to the test connection they were recorded from. Work has been started on defining CG&E's future process utilizing the CP Tool.

Work has begun on defining the process for using the Smallworld Survey Tool for CG&E's leak surveys.

CG&E and Convergent continue to work together to develop the Gas Odor Reporting Tool within ED SIP.

CG&E will continue to report to the Commission on the progress toward development of this tool.
