EXHIBIT C

The Applicant, Little Miami Communications Corporation, hereby wants to grandfather the Advanced Calling Services (ACS) Privacy Pack bundle to existing customers, effective February 15, 2007. The service will not be available to new customers after this date. The Applicant has realized that the Total Talk Pack bundle, which was introduced in 2004, is a better value for its customers than the ACS Privacy Pack. The Total Talk Pack bundle includes the same services as the ACS Privacy Pack, and more, at a reasonable rate.

No other language or rate changes are being made at this time. The grandfathering of the ACS Privacy Pack will have no immediate impact on current subscribers to that package. Therefore, to avoid confusion, the Applicant did not send a notice to those customers.

Current customers may continue to subscribe to the ACS Privacy Pack as long as they wish. Only if a customer no longer chooses to subscribe to any of the included services would the customer lose the ACS Privacy Pack. In other words, customers may make other changes to their service (unrelated to the components of the ACS Privacy Pack) without losing this grandfathered bundle of services. At the time a customer wishes to discontinue one of the services included within the ACS Privacy Pack bundle of services, a customer service representative will inform the customer that he or she will no longer have the ACS Privacy Pack and will not be able to re-subscribe to it.
