ENTRY

The Commission finds:

- (1) On August 16, 1999, Thomas L. Robinson (Complainant) filed a complaint with the Commission against East Ohio Gas Company (East Ohio, Respondent). Complainant alleges that East Ohio billed him too much for the gas service to his residence for the months May and June 1999.
- (2) On September 8, 1999, Respondent filed its answer in this case denying the substance of the complaint.
- (3) By Entry dated October 4, 1999, the Attorney Examiner scheduled this matter for a hearing to be held on November 2, 1999.
- (4) The Attorney Examiner conducted the hearing as scheduled on November 2, 1999.
- (5) Complainant failed to appear at the November 2, 1999 hearing in this case. At no time, either prior to or subsequent to the hearing date, has Complainant requested a continuance or indicated a desire to further pursue this matter.
- (6) Because Complainant has failed to actively pursue his complaint in this case, this case should be dismissed and closed as a matter of record.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That this case be dismissed and closed as a matter of record It is, further,

ORDERED, That a copy of this Entry be served upon each party of record.


