1. Ohio Edison is a public utility, as defined by §4905.03(A)(4), O.R.C. and is

duly organized and existing under the laws of the State of Ohio.

2. Complainant's narrative Complaint is not in a form allowing specific admission or denial as to individual allegations. Accordingly, Ohio Edison generally denies the allegations set out therein.

3. Ohio Edison further avers that it has, at various times, provided electric utility service to premises located at 4855 ½ St. Rt. 545 UPPR, Ashland, Ohio 44805 ("Premises").

4. Ohio Edison further avers that it currently maintains an account in the Complainant's name, which account reflects charges incurred for the provision of electric utility service.

5. Ohio Edison admits that a landlord agreement exists between Complainant and Ohio Edison.

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Ohio Edison avers that an account balance of \$443.58 exists for electric service rendered to Premises, Account No. 110049788471, from April 11, 2006 to September 12, 2006.

Ohio Edison denies the allegations set forth in numbered sentences 1-8 of the

8. Ohio Edison generally denies all allegations set forth in the Complaint that were not otherwise specifically addressed hereinabove.
