ENTRY

The attorney examiner finds:

- (1) On April 5, 2005, the Commission issued Certificate No. 03-099 to the city of Westlake (Westlake) to provide governmental aggregation service. The expiration date for Certificate 03-099 was March 28, 2007.
- (2) On March 15, 2007, Westlake filed a motion for an extension of the expiration date of its existing certificate. In its motion, Westlake stated that it inadvertently failed to file an application for renewal of its certificate within the time frame set forth in Rule 4901:1-27-09(A), Ohio Administrative Code. Westlake indicated that there have been no material changes in the operation of its aggregation program and the extension of the certificate expiration date is necessary to prevent irreparable harm to Westlake and its aggregation participants.
- (3) The examiner believes that an extension of the expiration date of Certificate No. 03-099 to April 23, 2007, is warranted so that Westlake's customers will not be adversely affected while its renewal application is under consideration.


It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That a copy of this entry be served upon all parties of record.


