The attorney examiner finds:

- (1) On September 7, 2005, the Cincinnati Gas & Electric Company, now known as Duke Energy Ohio, Inc., filed a complaint pursuant to Sections 4939.06 and 4905.26, Revised Code, stating that it does not accept Amberley Village's Ordinance 2005-14, relating to rights of way, and that the ordinance is unreasonable, unjust, unjustly discriminatory and/or unlawful.
- (2) On March 2, 2007, the attorney examiner filed an entry scheduling a settlement conference to occur on April 5, 2007. Counsel for Duke has informed the examiner that settlement between the parties is almost complete. Therefore, Duke requests that the settlement conference be postponed.
- (3) The examiner finds that the request is reasonable and that, therefore, the settlement conference should be rescheduled. A settlement conference will now be held on Tuesday, April 24, 2007, at 10:00 a.m., at the offices of the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio, 180 East Broad Street, Columbus, Ohio 43215, on the 11th floor, Hearing Room 11-B.
