ENTRY

The Commission finds:

- (1) On June 29, 2006, Donald Kocisko dba Rustic Meadows (Mr. Kocisko) filed a complaint against Ohio Edison Company, alleging that Ohio Edison was billing his business for electric usage that had occurred under a prior owner at that location.
- (2) Ohio Edison responded on July 20, 2006, by agreeing that it had billed Mr. Kocisko for electric usage at the address he had indicated and in the amount he had stated. Ohio Edison denied all of Mr. Kocisko's remaining allegations.
- (3) By Entry dated July 28, 2006, the attorney examiner scheduled a prehearing conference for September 7, 2006. The prehearing conference was held as scheduled and matters were not resolved at that time. However, following the prehearing conference, Ohio Edison agreed to investigate matters. As a result, the parties continued discussions during September-November 2006, and a settlement was proposed and agreed upon in early February 2007.
- (4) Ohio Edison filed a joint motion to dismiss on March 12, 2007, stating that the parties have reached an informal settlement intended to resolve all issues. The joint motion also asks the Commission to dismiss the proceeding.
- (5) The Commission concludes that granting the joint motion to dismiss is appropriate.



ORDERED, That a copy of this entry be served upon all parties of record.




