The Commission finds:

- (1) On October 11, 2006, Steven R. Burnfield filed a complaint against American Electric Power/Columbus Southern Power Company (AEP). In the complaint, Mr. Burnfield stated that he frequently had experienced momentary power outages in the spring and summer of 2006 and that, because of the outages, his television set was destroyed. AEP filed an answer denying the material allegations in the complaint.
- (2) A prehearing settlement conference was held on January 31, 2007; however, the parties failed to resolve this matter at that time.
- (3) Subsequent to the conference, Mr. Burnfield filed a letter withdrawing his request for a hearing.
- (4) In view of Mr. Burnfield's withdrawal in this matter, the complaint should be dismissed and this case should be closed of record.

ORDERED, That the above-captioned complaint be dismissed and this case be closed of record. It is, further,




