The attorney examiner finds:

- (1) On May 31, 2005, Mr. and Mrs. Bradley J. Bennett, Sr. (Complainants) filed a complaint against Utility Operators Corporation (UOC). In their complaint, Complainants allege that UOC was operating an inadequate facility, causing severe damage to their home.
- (2) On June 15, 2005, UOC filed its answer in this proceeding, denying the complainant's allegations and alleging that the damage was due to heavy rains caused by the hurricanes in September, 2004.
- (3) A prehearing conference was held on August 3, 2005. A second prehearing conference was held on November 30, 2005; the parties continued informal negotiations but were unable to resolve this matter.
- (4) By entry dated March 16, 2007, the attorney examiner scheduled this case for hearing on April 26, 2007. However, on March 26, 2007, the Respondent requested a one week continuance due to a scheduling conflict.
- (5) The attorney examiner finds that Respondent's motion for a continuance is reasonable and should be granted. Therefore, the hearing in this proceeding should be rescheduled for May 3, 2007, at 10:00 a.m. at the offices of the Commission,
