To Whom It May Concern:

I am a land owner in the path of the proposed Rockies Express-East pipeline. My property is located at 2945 North State Route 741, Franklin, Ohio. On the attached map I have shown the perimeter (borders) of my farm as well as the proposed 42" pipeline. According to REX documents, the proposed 42" pipeline would have a 50 foot wide permanent easement and be installed 30" below the ground level (grade). The proposed pipeline will follow south of the existing 5 pipelines and turn north for several feet before exiting my property.

Please be advised that my farm, 102 acres, and buildings are in the Registrar of Historic Places filed under the name Hunt-Forman Farm District #04000607. My farm has been in the Forman name for 4 generations (141 years) and is listed with the Ohio Department of Agriculture as an Ohio Century Farm under the name Forman Farm, for being owned by the same family for more than 100 years.


I prefer not to have my rich historic farm land disturbed by the typical pipeline trenching. I recommend that my section or parcel of land be bypassed or directional boring be used. Please impose the standard procedure for directional boring or redirecting the pipeline around my property.

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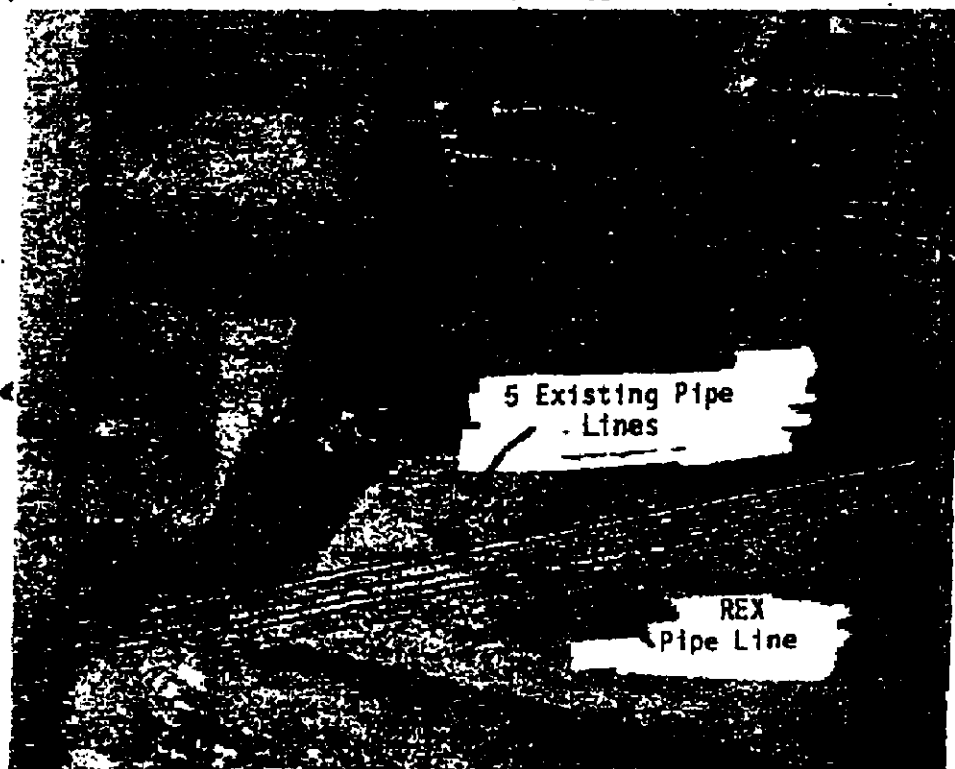
