ENTRY

The Commission finds:

- (1) On November 20, 2006, Tiffany Ridge Townhouse Condominium Unit Owners' Association, Inc. (complainant) filed a complaint alleging that Cleveland Electric Illuminating Company (CEI) improperly redirected one of the power lines that served a pump station to the complainant, causing flooding and property damage.
- (2) A settlement conference was held; however, the parties failed to resolve this matter. A hearing was subsequently scheduled for May 8, 2007.
- (3) On May 8, 2007, complainant filed a notice of dismissal of the complaint without prejudice. Accordingly, the complaint should be dismissed without prejudice.






