ENTRY

The administrative law judge finds:

- (1) On April 20, 1992, the Ohio Power Siting Board (Board) issued an Opinion, Order, and Certificate, in Case No. 91-1660-EL-BTX (91-1660), granting the application of The Dayton Power and Light Company (DP&L) for a certificate for the relocation 2.25 miles of the Greene-Sugarcreek 138 kV Circuit to accommodate the NBL Golf Course Development project in Greene County, Ohio.
- (2) On May 16, 2007, DP&L filed an application to amend the certificate issued in 91-1660. The proposed amendment is to relocate a portion of the original relocated line, what is being called the Relocation of the Greene-Alpha 138 kV Circuit at Shepherd Road project. The project is located in Greene County, at the Beaver Creek and Sugarcreek Township line where the line crosses Shepherd Road. The project will rebuild and relocate a short section of the Greene-Alpha existing 138 kV transmission line to accommodate a new housing development in the area of the transmission line. The amendment application proposes to change the location of two wood poles structures on the line and the alignment between them.
- (3) In an investigative report filed May 22, 2007, the Board's staff stated that it had reviewed the application and had determined that the proposed amendment would not result in any significant adverse social or environmental impact pursuant to Rule 4906-5-10(B)(1), Ohio Administrative Code (O.A.C.).

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- (4) In accordance with Rule 4906-5-10(B)(1)(b), O.A.C., DP&L shall serve a copy of the amendment application upon such persons and parties as set forth in Rule 4906-5-10(B)(2)(a), O.A.C., to the extent not already done so. ATSI shall also give public notice in newspapers of general circulation in the area involved with the amendment within seven days of this entry, as required by Section 4906.06(C) and (E), Revised Code. The notice shall read as follows:


The Dayton Power and Light Company has filed an application with the Ohio Power Siting Board in Case No. 07-599-EL-BTA seeking to amend a certificate of environmental compatibility and public need issued for the relocation of the Greene-Sugarcreek 138 kV Circuit in Greene County, Ohio. The purpose of the requested amendment is to rebuild and relocate a short section of the Greene-Alpha existing 138 kV transmission line at the Beavercreek and Sugarcreek Township line where the line crosses Shepherd Road to accommodate a new housing development in the area of the transmission line. The amendment application proposes to change the location of two wood pole structures on the line and the alignment between them. More information may be obtained by contacting the offices of the Ohio Power Siting Board, 180 East Broad Street, Columbus, Ohio 43215-3793 or by reviewing a copy of the amendment application at the main library in your area. Interested persons wishing to file objections to the proposed change may do so by filing written objections to the Ohio Power Siting Board within 10 days of this notice.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That DP&L serve copies of the amendment application and give public notice in accordance with Finding 4. It is, further,

ORDERED, That a copy of this entry be served upon all interested persons of record.


