The attorney examiner finds:

- (1) A hearing in this matter was scheduled for May 16, 2007.
- (2) Commission staff has filed a motion for a continuance of the hearing. In support of the motion, staff stated that the parties are engaged in on-going settlement negotiations, which may result in the resolution of this case without the need for a hearing.
- (3) The request for a continuance of the hearing should be granted. The hearing in this matter should be continued until June 27, 2007, at 10:00 a.m., in hearing room 11-B, in the offices of the Commission, 180 East Broad Street, Columbus, Ohio.
- (4) Rule 4901-1-08, Ohio Administrative Code, requires that all corporations must be represented by an attorney-at-law authorized to practice in Ohio.
- (5) Pursuant to Section 4901.14, Revised Code, a regularly salaried employee of a transportation corporation can make a presentation of facts in the case at hearing, but cannot act as an attorney. More specifically, such an employee cannot examine witnesses, make motions, or file legal briefs.

ORDERED, That the hearing in this matter be continued until June 27, 2007, at 10:00 a.m., in hearing room 11-B, in the offices of the Commission. It is, further,
