

On May 21, 2007 FirstEnergy Service Company on behalf of American Transmission Systems, Incorporated (ATSI) and The Cleveland Electric Illuminating Company (CEI), submitted a Letter of Notification for a project involving installation a three-pole tap structure and tapping two existing Eastlake-Lloyd 138 kV transmission lines to supply a new customer owned substation. Although the letters to local government representatives were sent out on May 21, 2007 as stated in the LON, the copy intended for submittal to docketing was inadvertently omitted from the submittal. Dear Commissioner Hagan,

American Transmission Systems, Inc. ("ATSI") and The Cleveland Electric Illuminating Company ("CEI"), FirstEnergy Corp. subsidiaries, in the Eastlake-Lloyd 138 kV Transmission Line Tap To the Progressive Substation Project, are jointly proposing to install a double circuit transmission line tap from two existing transmission line circuits to a new customer owned substation. The project involves installing a new three-pole transmission line tap structure along the centerline of ATSI's existing Eastlake-Lloyd Q12-EL-LY-X & Q13-EL-LY-X 138 kV transmission lines with two short transmission line taps to a new substation being installed at Progressive Corporation. The project is located on the east side of I-271, approximately 1,800 feet west of the intersection of Parkview Drive and State Route 91 (SOM Center Road) in the Village of Mayfield in Cuyahoga County, Ohio. The Eastlake-Lloyd Q12-EL-LY-X & Q13-EL-LY-X 138 kV transmission lines are located on a common series of steel pole structures. The Progressive substation is a new customer owned substation that will be located immediately adjacent to the tap structure partially within the right-of-way of the existing transmission line.

In accordance with the provisions of Ohio Administrative Code ("OAC") Rule 4906-1-01, installation of the transmission line tap is under the jurisdiction of the Ohio Power Siting Board, and their requirements for a Letter of Notification ("LON"). Therefore, in compliance with OAC 4906-11-01 of the OPSB's Rules and Regulations, we have prepared and filed the attached LON with the OPSB for their review and approval. The LON contains a description of the transmission line tap project, and is provided for your information.
