AT&T Ohio proposes to modify its AT&T Tariff P.U.C.O. No. 20 to establish an exception to the F.C.C. Tariff No. 2 for Special Access Services. F.C.C. No. 2 has been revised to reduce certain Access circuit rates in compliance with AT&T's Merger Commitment #6 made to the FCC in the AT&T/Bell South merger. Per AT&T's letter to the FCC dated December 28, 2006, AT&T has filed "interstate tariffs" establishing discounted rates for DS1, DS3, and Ethernet services. This filing is being made to clarify the rates in the F.C.C. No. 2 tariff that apply to intrastate services.
