The Commission finds:


- (1) On August 24, 1998, pursuant to a stipulation approved by this Commission in Case No. 91-410-EL-AIR, The Cincinnati Gas & Electric Company (CG&E) filed an application seeking the approval of the Commission to enter into a services agreement to permit the sale and purchases of services with its affiliated companies.
- (2) The stipulation referenced in Finding (1) requires, among other things, that 60 days prior to the filing of an affiliate contract with the Securities and Exchange Commission (SEC), CG&E file a copy of the contract or an amendment to the contract with this Commission.
- (3) In a letter to the SEC dated February 2, 1999, the Commission notified the Assistant Director, Office of Public Utility Regulation of the Division of Investment Management, that this Commission and the Staff of this Commission had no objections to CG&E's proposed Utility-Nonutility Services Agreement.
- (4) There is no further action required of the Commission in this case. Therefore, Case No. 98-1183-GE-CMT should be closed as a matter of record.

ORDERED, That Case No. 98-1183-GE-CMT be closed as a matter of record. It is, further,

ORDERED, That a copy of this Entry be served upon each party of record.



