1. Informal request by FERC Project Manager, Laura Turner to submit searchable database for all affected landowners along with a link to responses to affected landowners, property specific concerns and/or issues related to the proposed REX-East pipeline project.

Rockies Express has developed a searchable database for use in identifying affected landowners along the proposed Rockies Express – East Project alignment. The affected landowners in the database correspond to those identified on project alignment drawings submitted as part of Volume 3, Non-Internet Public documents with Rockies Express's April 30, 2007 application filing. Additionally, as requested a link to this database with landowner specific issues and Rockies Express responses is provided. The specific issues information was developed following guidance provided by FERC staff during the Rockies Express East Project Pre-Filing activities and summarized below.

Rockies Express personnel reviewed all documents submitted to the FERC in regards to the Pre-filing scoping process to determine,

1. Is the author of the document an affected landowner per the FERC definition provided in Title 18CFR, Part §157.6?
2. Does the affected landowner document address a property specific issue or concern (i.e. planned pond development, known springs, cultural artifacts, etc.)?


Rockies Express continues to monitor documents submitted to the FERC regarding property specific issues and whether the author is an affected landowner. Rockies Express will update the information monthly and weekly prior to issuance of a Draft Environmental Impact Statement.

Where landowners are willing, Rockies Express representatives continue to meet with landowners and attempt to minimize project related impacts as much as possible.
