Dear Ms. Jenkins:

AT&T Ohio (which is the name under which The Ohio Bell Telephone Company does business) (the "Company") hereby files revised maps of its Beavercreek and Fairborn exchanges, without application, pursuant to Ohio Administrative Code §4901:1-3-03(F). Reduced copies of the revised maps, size 8 ½" x 11", reflecting the proposed boundary changes, are also attached. Both this letter and the reduced maps are being filed in duplicate pursuant to Ohio Administrative Code §4901:1-3-03(G).

The revised maps reflect the incorporation of portions of AT&T Ohio's Fairborn Exchange into it Beavercreek Exchange. The Company provides the following reason for making this change:

A new residential subdivision (Spring Ridge) is under construction and is located within the Fairborn Exchange. The impacted area is 32,500' from the Fairborn Central Office and 29,300' from the Beavercreek Central Office. To serve this development from Fairborn would require placement of approximately 4,000' of copper cable, while serving this new subdivision from Beavercreek would require minimal placement of fiber cable. In addition to economic costs, this move would enable service to the new development using AT&T's newest fiber technologies.

This change will appear in the southeast corner of the Fairborn Exchange map and the northeast corner of the Beavercreek Exchange map. The new boundary runs north of Beaver Valley Road and west of New Germany Trebein Road.

The Company confirms that this change will not adversely affect the service being furnished to any existing subscriber.

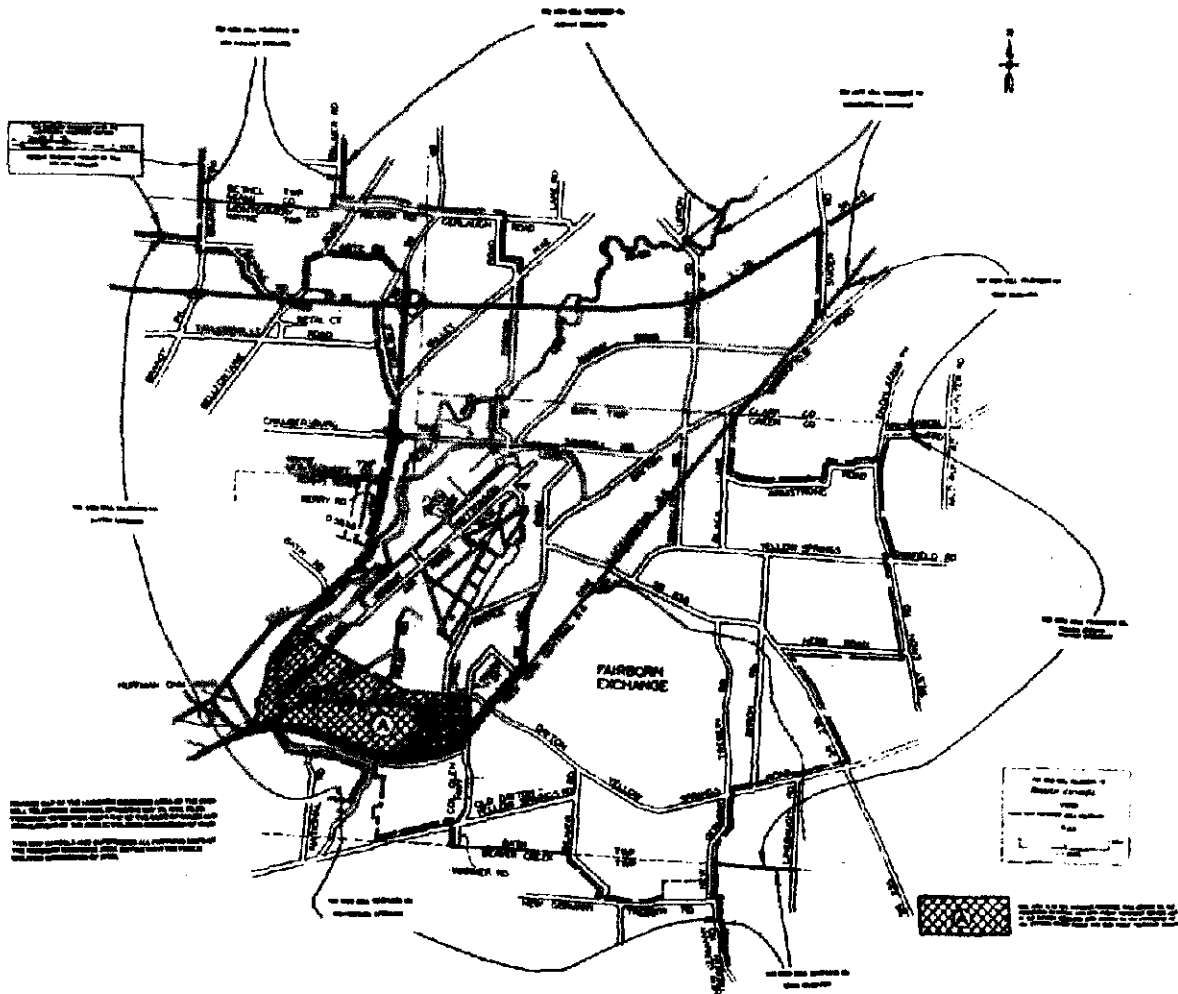
