MCImetro Access Transmission Services LLC d/b/a Verizon Access Transmission Services ("Verizon Access") is filing with your office an original and ten (10) copies of revisions to its P.U.C.O. Tariff No. 4.

Verizon Access proposes to 1) grandfather the Verizon Loyalty Plus I Plan; 2) increase the per line/trunk/T1 Order Expedite charges associated with Verizon Business Services II Local and Verizon Business Services II Local and Long Distance; 3) grandfather the Flat Local Line monthly charge associated with Verizon Business Services II Local and introduce a new Flat Local Line increased monthly charge; 4) grandfather the Flat Local Trunk and Local ISDN-PRI monthly charges associated with Verizon Business Services II Local and introduce new Flat Local Trunk and Local ISDN-PRI reduced monthly charges; 5) grandfather the Metered Rate Pricing Structure associated with Verizon Business Services II Local; 6) grandfather the Offering A Local Line monthly charge associated with Verizon Business Services II Local and Long Distance and introduce a new Offering A Local Line increased monthly charge; 7) grandfather the Offering B Local Trunk monthly charge associated with Verizon Business Services II Local and Long Distance and introduce a new Offering B Local Trunk reduced monthly charge; 8) grandfather the Verizon Business Services II Flex T1 Plus Plan; 9) increase the monthly recurring charges associated with the following residential service offerings: Residential RLC, RLD (SBC Ohio), RLD-3 and RLG Services; and 10) make various textual revisions. Affected customers were notified of these rate increases via a message in their monthly invoice.

Verizon Access respectfully requests an effective date of July 1, 2007.




