I have reviewed the findings of the field visit and the conclusions and recommendations report from Mr. Shawn Zurfley. The proposed changes to the location of the cantilevered warning devices is acceptable to the City of Cleveland provided the sidewalk is modified as necessary so that there is a minimum of 4-ft of unobstructed sidewalk either in front or behind the signal. Further, any new sidewalk area necessitated by this change must be constructed on public R/W or railroad R/W property and not on private property.
