The proposed changes to the location of the cantilevered warning devices is acceptable to the City of Cleveland provided the sidewalk is modified as necessary so that there is a minimum of 4-ft of unobstructed sidewalk either in front or behind the signal. Further, any new sidewalk area necessitated by this change must be constructed on public R/W or railroad R/W property and not on private property.
