

**REQUEST OF VERIZON NORTH INC. TO RETURN NUMBERS IT
PREVIOUSLY DONATED TO THE POOL**

Verizon North Inc. ("Verizon") submits this request for Commission review and asks that it overturn a decision by NeuStar – Pooling Administration ("NeuStar") denying the return to Verizon of ten blocks of numbers that Verizon had earlier donated to the pool. On January 25, 2007, Verizon requested the "0" blocks for ten codes from NeuStar. On that same date NeuStar denied nine of the requests because Verizon's utilization rate was below 75% and it denied the remaining one request by stating that Verizon sought more blocks than it will exhaust in six months based on criteria set forth in the Central Office Code (NXX) Guidelines.

When KMC, a CLEC operating in Ohio, ceased providing service, Verizon was the only carrier with a customer using the codes that KMC used. Therefore, Verizon became the Local Exchange Routing Guide ("LERG") assignee for approximately 60 codes. After Verizon acquired these 60 codes, it donated excess codes to the pool. However, Verizon retained the "0" block of codes. Verizon must maintain the "0" blocks to report on the codes that Verizon is assigned; due to system requirements, one block of a code, or the "0" blocks of each series (i.e, 0XXX, 1XXX, 2XXX....9XXX), must be maintained in order to prepare the reports. Also, Verizon must retain the "0" blocks to

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accurately report the current number utilization semiannually to the National Resource Utilization Forecast of the Federal Communications Commission ("FCC") and the respective state commissions. In August 2006, Verizon made additional donations to the pool and, at that time, some of the "0" blocks were erroneously donated to the pool. Therefore, since August 2006, Verizon has not reported on several codes that were assigned to it. NeuStar is now questioning why Verizon did not report on specific blocks. Currently, Verizon cannot report the status of these codes to NeuStar, i.e., working or available, because the Verizon's system reflects "post donation" status.

Verizon requires return of the "0" number blocks that it mistakenly donated so it can continue to meet its reporting requirements. Thus, in this Request, Verizon asks that the "0" blocks it donated in error be returned. To obtain return of these "0" blocks, Verizon must obtain a waiver from this Commission.

Specifically, Verizon seeks the following 0XXX block numbers beginning with telephone numbers:

(937) 822-3000 Georgetown.

Attachment A reflects the Application Forms to NeuStar, the Months-to-Exhaust Worksheets, and the Denials from NeuStar.

The FCC's rules set forth a procedure to bring the denial of a numbering resource to the appropriate state commission for review. 47 CFR § 52.15(g)(3)(iv) provides as follows:

(iv) The NANPA shall withhold numbering resources from any U.S. Carrier that fails to comply with the reporting and numbering resource application requirements established in this part. The NANPA shall not issue numbering resources to a carrier without an Operating Company Number (OCN). The NANPA must notify the carrier in writing of its decision to withhold numbering resources within ten (10) days of receiving a request for numbering resources. The carrier may challenge the NANPA's decision to the appropriate state regulatory commission. The state regulatory commission may affirm or overturn its determination of compliance with the reporting and numbering resource application requirements herein.

Additionally, the FCC's December 12, 2001, Order in its Number Resource Optimization Report and Order, CC Docket No. 99-200, FCC No. 01-362, paragraph 64 states that a carrier: "...should be able to get additional numbering resources when there is a verifiable need due to the carrier's inability to satisfy a specific customer request." In addition, paragraph 64 says "States may not accommodate requests for specific numbers (i.e., vanity numbers), but may grant requests for customers seeking contiguous blocks of numbers." *Id.* Verizon submits that this request demonstrates a clear requirement for this Commission's review and reversal of NeuStar's decisions.

For the reasons set forth herein, Verizon requests that the Commission overturn NeuStar's decisions to withhold the numbering resource that Verizon requested on January 25, 2007.


