# MEMORANDUM IN SUPPORT OF MOTION TO INTERVENE OF THE THE UTILITY WORKERS UNION OF AMERICA, LOCAL NUMBER 270

Pursuant to Ohio Revised Code §4903.22.1 and Ohio Administrative Code §4901-01-11, the Public Utility Commission of Ohio ("Commission") should grant leave to intervene of the Utility Workers Union of America, Local Number 270 ("UWUA Local 270") in this proceeding.

UWUA Local 270 has a real and substantial interest in these proceedings. Local 270 is the collective bargaining representatives that represent over 1000 employees of the Cleveland Electric Illuminating Company.
