Pursuant to Ohio Administrative Code $4901: 1-5-16$ ("MTSS Rule 16"), Verizon North Inc. requesis a waiver of paragraphs (A) and (B) of the MTSS Rule 16 due to verifiable Acts of God beginning on August 19, 2007.

As a result of severe rainfall, lightening, winds, many Verizon exchanges are flooding and causing thousands of service ourages and difficulty accessing certain areas to make needed repairs. The precipitation from the recent weather has caused severe flood-related impediments to service restoration such as road closures, damaged urility lines, cte. As a result of excessive weather, Verizon is requesting a waiver in the affected counties.

As of August 22, 2007, Govemor Strickland had declared emergencies in Allen, Crawford, Hancock, Hardin, Puroam, Richland, Seneca, Van Wert and Wyandot counties.

At this time, Verizon is not prepared to filc a detailed list of exchanges and cusfomers affected. Verizon is compiling this data and will be prepared to file it along with other pertinent details and documentation as soon as feasible.
