MEMORANDUM IN SUPPORT


On July 10, 2007 the Ohio Edison Company, the Cleveland Electric Illuminating Company, and The Toledo Edison Company (“Companies”) filed, pursuant to Section 4928.14, Revised Code, and Chapter 4901:1-35, Ohio Administrative Code (O.A.C.), their application for approval of a competitive bidding process designed to procure supply beginning January 1, 2009, for the provision of Standard Service Offer electric generation to the Companies’ retail electric customers who do not purchase electric generation service from a competitive supplier.

FPL Energy is involved in the competitive supply of electricity. FPL Energy is actively involved in the electricity and natural gas markets in various states throughout the region, including Virginia, Delaware, New Jersey, Pennsylvania, and West Virginia. FPL Energy also is active in the PJM Interconnection, L.L.C (“PJM”) and Midwest Independent System Operator (“MISO”) wholesale power markets. FPL Energy is a subsidiary of FPL Group, Inc., a publicly traded company.


