ENTRY

The Commission finds:

- (1) By finding and order of July 11, 2007, the Commission approved a stipulation in this case regarding applications filed by Duke Energy Ohio, formerly The Cincinnati Gas & Electric Company, (Duke) to implement a set of electric and natural gas demand side management (DSM) programs for residential, commercial, and industrial consumers, as well as a research DSM program.
- (2) Footnote (2) set forth in the July 11, 2007 finding and order identified the minimum kW demand necessary for qualifying customers permitted to opt out of participation in the DSM programs. Per Duke's tariff filed with the Commission for the DSM programs, footnote (2) in the July 11, 2007 finding and order should have indicated that non-residential customers, whose single site load in the company's service territory exceeds 1,000 kW per month or total aggregate load in the

company's certified service territory exceeds, 1,500 kW per month are permitted to opt-out of participation in and payment for the DSM programs.


