Please find this correspondence in reference to the proposed Rockies Express Pipeline (REX) East Project Docket # CP07-208-000. We would like to respectfully submit letters from concerned citizens as well as resolutions and letters of support from local government entities that stand in support of the alternate route for the 42" natural gas pipeline in hopes of diverting around the Slope Creek Reservoir. A map of the proposed reroute is also included.

Slope creek Reservoir is a 750 million-gallon water storage facility that serves raw water to be processed for use by a portion of the population in four counties in Ohio. Four water distribution companies distribute water into Belmont, Monroe, Guernsey, and Noble counties. The concern of possible contamination of these waters jeopardizes the health and safety of approximately 12,400 residents of the immediate area.

As representative for the Ohio Sixth Congressional District, I am writing on behalf of the Village of Barnesville and the Rockies Express Pipeline Project – East (Federal Energy Regulatory Commission Docket No. CP07-208-000).

The Rockies Express Pipeline Project-East (REX-East) has been submitted to FERC inclusive of a proposed section which would run underneath the Slope Creek Reservoir in Somerset Township, Belmont County, Ohio. The Slope Creek Reservoir is the primary source of fresh water for the Barnesville Water Department which supplies water to 12,400 local residents in four different counties. This proposal has raised scrious concerns within the local community regarding the continued safety of the area's water supply.

In the interest of preserving the public's confidence in the availability of a sufficient supply of safe, fresh water, I write to issue my support for the rerouting of the REX-East pipeline. I respectfully request that FERC, as the lead federal agency overseeing the permitting process for the REX-East gas line, consider the local concerns regarding the siting of the REX-East line under the Slope Creek Reservoir and look favorably upon a viable alternative.




