19	KENNETH N. ROSSELET
20	being first duly sworn, as prescribed by law, was
21	examined and testified as follows:
22	DIRECT EXAMINATION
23	By Mr. Petricoff:
24	Q. Mr. Stenger, I'd like to hand you what

- has been marked Joint Exhibit No. 1. Do you recognize that document?
 - A. I do.

- Q. Could you state your name and business address for the record?
- A. Yes. It's John T. Stenger, 5181 College Corner Pike, Oxford, Ohio, 45056.
- Q. Mr. Stenger, could you recite for us your educational training and your work experience in the natural gas industry?
- A. Yes. I have Bachelor degrees in civil engineering and land surveying from Purdue University and a Master in business administration from Xavier University. I have worked after Cinergy Corp, which is now Duke Energy, for a little over 13 years. I've spent a little over three years as the operating officer for Lawrenceburg Gas Company, and since July of 2006, I have operations manager for the Oxford Natural Gas Company.
- Q. And could you relate for us how your appointment came about as the manager of the Oxford Natural Gas Company?
- A. Yes. Thee was a court order ordering the previous majority partner out of the daily operations

- and appointing me as the operations manager for the company.
 - Q. And are you authorized to testify today on behalf of the Oxford Natural Gas Company?
 - A. Yes, I am.

- Q. Are you the same John T. Stenger who filed supplemental and additional supplement after testimony in this proceeding?
 - A. Yes, I am.
- Q. Okay. Previously I have handed to you a document that has been marked as Joint Exhibit No. 1. Did you take part in the negotiations that produced that document?
 - A. Yes, I did.
- Q. Could you tell us briefly the nature of those negotiations?
- A. Yes. There were numerous issues discussed between the City of Oxford, the PUCO staff and Oxford Natural Gas Company, and over the course of several months, we negotiated those to this conclusion.
- Q. Would you agree that the negotiations were serious and conducted between knowledgeable parties?

A. Yes, they were.

- Q. How would the average residential customer be affected by this proposed stipulation?
- A. Per the stipulated base rate, the average residential customer's bill will be reduced approximately 22 percent. Its customer service charge will be reduced approximately 19 percent.
 - Q. How about commercial customers?
- A. They are under the same rate structure, so they will also receive the same rate decreases.
- Q. How will industrial and large institutional customers be affected by this stipulation?
- A. Those customers in Oxford's territory are special contract customers, and, as such, they would not be affected by this Stipulation and Recommendation.
- Q. In your opinion is this Stipulation and Recommendation in the public interest?
 - A. It is, yes.
- Q. Okay. Are you aware in your experience of any regulatory principle or practice that is violated by this stipulation?
 - A. No, I am not.
