Under Case No. 06-1152-RR-FED dated October 4, 2006 the Commission ordered Norfolk Southern Railway (NS) to install an active grade crossing warning device at the following location by October 4, 2007:

Lucas County, near Maumee, Stitt Rd/CR 128, DOT# 475-230N

On October 1, 2007 NS filed in this docket a request for a 30 day extension of time to complete the project. NS states that on September 25, 2007 the Ohio Rail Development Commission (ORDC) expanded the scope of the project by requesting an additional flashing unit to be installed at the crossing. NS states that this has added additional time for engineering and installation.

Although staff notes that the request is made at a late date, staff recommends that the request by NS be granted due to the expanded scope of the project.
