Revision to a Territorial Boundary Map.)

ENTRY

The Commission finds:

- (1) Columbus Southern Power Company (CSP) and Consolidated Electric Cooperative, Inc. (CECI) are electric suppliers as defined in Section 4933.81, Revised Code.
- (2) Certification by the Commission of the territories of CSP and CECI was approved by entries in Case No. 78-1311-EL-ORD.
- (3) CSP and CECI have jointly petitioned the Commission to reallocate their service territories in Hilliard Township, Knox County, Ohio. Specifically, they request the following relocation:

On Quadrangle map L-18, include an overlap Area "A" served by CSP in CECI territory as represented on the attached map and physically addressed as 2719 Lytle Road, Centerburg, Ohio, 43011.

- (4) In support of their request, CSP and CECI state that a new customer has requested service from CECI. Due to the customer's distance from CECI facilities, it is not practicable for CECI to provide service to the customer. CSP has an existing transformer approximately 150 feet from the new customer's residence and is willing to provide electric service to the customer.
- (5) Section 4933.83 (E), Revised Code, provides in pertinent part:

Notwithstanding the effectuation of certified territories established by or pursuant to sections 4933.81 to 4933.90 of the Revised Code, and the exclusive right of electric suppliers to serve within such territory, and notwithstanding any other provisions of such sections establishing rights of electric suppliers to furnish electric service, any two or more electric suppliers may jointly

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petition the commission for the reallocation of their own territories and electric load centers among them and designating which portions of such territories and electric load centers are to be served by each of the electric suppliers.

- (6) No exception to the change described in Finding (3) has been brought to the Commission's attention.
- (7) The Commission finds that granting the requested relief will promote the purposes of Sections 4933.81 to 4933.90, Revised Code, and will further promote the provision of adequate service to all territories and electric load centers affected by the relocation. Accordingly, the Commission shall order the appropriate modification of the territorial boundary of CSP and CECI.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That the request of CSP and CECI to relocate their territory boundary is granted. It is, further,


ORDERED, That the change on quadrangle map L-18, described in Finding (3), be approved to show the boundary line change. It is, further,

ORDERED, That a copy of this Entry be served upon each party of record.


